### **Maths**

This week we finished our fractions unit. The children learned how to find a fraction of an amount, find the whole, and use fractions as operators. They also completed the end-of-unit assessment and practised their arithmetic skills.

### **English**

In English, we focused on relative clauses and created a biography toolkit. The children researched the life of Michael Morpurgo and began writing a biography about him, using the features we have learned.

### **Science**

In science, the children carried out an investigation to test whether the same material can keep hot things hot and cold things cold. Using a cool bag, they compared hot water and ice cubes, placing one cup inside the bag and one outside. They measured and recorded the temperature over time to see how effective the material was.

### **Topic**

In topic lessons, the children researched Mayan gods and learned more about Ancient Maya religion and beliefs.

### **Computing**

In computing, we continued learning about video recording and editing and used a storyboard to plan and film on the iPads, experimenting with different filming techniques.
