



TIGER CLASS



In English, Tiger Class have been extending their knowledge of subordinating clauses and how a comma should always be included if a subordinating conjunction is at the start of a sentence. The children have also been finding examples of the passive voice within the information text and using this when correcting over-long sentences. Tiger Class have also been developing their knowledge of cause-and-effect phrases, and the children have included these when turning an informal paragraph into a formal one.

In Maths, Tiger Class have been using the language of ratio. The children have learnt the ratio symbol and how to record ratio as a fraction. Tiger Class have ended the week learning about scale drawings and how to draw shapes from a given scale.

During the afternoons, Tiger class have been really busy working together to produce a collaborative piece of artwork, based on Van Gogh's Starry night. Each child created a section of the picture, using a variety of different media, of either oil pastels, pencil crayon or felt pen.

In Science, the children consolidated their knowledge on light and shadows and in R.E., they looked at data relating to different Worldviews.

In computing, the children have continued to use Microbit and in Music they have thought about how atmosphere is created in films through different types of music.
