English

In English this week, we have been researching famous archaeologist, Howard Carter. We learned about his life and the discovery of Tutankhamun's tomb! From this, we were able to write a biography about Howard Carter's life.

Maths

In maths this week, we have learnt that perimeter is the total length around the outside of a 2D shape. We have been calculating and measuring the perimeter of different 2D shapes.

Science

This week in science, we have been making sunglasses! We learnt about how the sun emits ultraviolet (UV) light, and identified how we can protect our eyes from its powerful rays. We found out that dark acetate was best to use for the lenses, as it was dark and partially blocked the sunlight.
