Maths

This week we started a new unit on decimal numbers. The children have been learning about numbers to two decimal places, equivalent fractions and decimals (tenths and hundredths), and how fractions and decimals link together. The children have been working really hard with this new learning.

English

In English, the children finished writing their biography about Michael Morpurgo. They then chose their own author to research and wrote an independent biography as their hot task to complete the unit.

Science

In science, we compared reusable and non-reusable nappies. The children explored the materials used and discussed their properties, such as waterproofness, absorbency, comfort and flexibility, to decide which was most suitable.

Computing

In computing, the children worked in groups to design their own storyboard, including filming techniques and a script. Their videos focus on Safer Internet Day and aim to explain how to stay safe online, highlighting what to do and what not to do when using the internet.
