English

In English this week, we started our new unit on poetry. We learnt parts of a poem in groups and worked hard to perform it as a class, which was brilliant! We also expressed how each section of the poem made us feel and made descriptive word banks that we will be able to use throughout the unit to write our own poems.

Maths

In maths this week, we have been learning about fractions. We learnt that the denominator (the bottom number) is the number of equal parts that a shape has been divided into, and the numerator (the top number) is the number of parts that have been shaded in. We have also been comparing and ordering non-unit fractions.

This term we are continuing to focus on learning our 3s, 4s and 8 times tables.

Science

This week in science, we have started our new topic on forces. We investigated how many ways we could move a tennis ball and wooden block and were able to identify that most of the ways we discovered were either pushing or pulling forces.

As we reached an impressive 3000 dojo points at the start of the week, this afternoon we had our reward! We have been watching the prince of Egypt, as this film fits well with our current topic. Next week, we will be learning more about Tutankhamun and his valuable treasures!
