### English

In English this week, we have been learning some of the features that we could include in our poems. So far, we have looked at similes, alliteration, onomatopoeia and personification. We have been writing some shorter poems to help us practice each of these features.

### Maths

In maths this week, we have been comparing and ordering fractions and counting in fractions on a number line. We have also started identifying equivalent fractions.
