### Maths

This week in maths, we have been rounding decimals to whole numbers and to one decimal place. We have also started learning about percentages and explored how percentages are equivalent to fractions.

### English

In English, we have continued learning our model text Smaug. The children have been practising writing sentences of three using the senses, learning how to use semi-colons, using show don't tell, and developing detailed descriptions of a monster. They worked in groups to write their own monster descriptions, thinking carefully about adding as much detail as possible. These descriptions will be used next week to generate AI images of their monsters, allowing the children to see their creations brought to life visually.
