



TIGER CLASS



In English, Tiger Class have been completing a range of activities linked to our story 'The Way Home.' The children have been 'Dialogue Detectives' by identifying errors within the writing. Tigers have also looked at two versions of a paragraph to identify the difference in the language features used. This week, the children have also learnt about internal monologue and have written paragraphs in the first person to demonstrate this. Tigers have been practising writing vivid, descriptive phrases before creating a plan for the shared write.

In Maths, Tiger Class have been recapping on how to find the perimeter and area of rectilinear shapes. The children have calculated the area of triangles by counting squares before being introduced to the formula for finding the area of right-angled triangles. The week has ended, with them applying this to any triangle.

During the afternoons, Tiger class have continued with their topic on 'The British Parliament' and on Monday they learnt more about how the country is governed and sketched pictures of the Houses of Parliament. On Wednesday, the children did some textile work in DT and made keyrings out of felt. On Thursday, we read more of Holes and Friday was a focus on Science week, with the theme being Curiosity.
