



TIGER CLASS



In English, Tiger Class have busy innovating a story based on the text 'The Way Home.' We have share written parts of the story and children have identified language features used within a model paragraph before writing their own version.

In Maths, Tiger Class have been learning about volume. The children initially began by counting the number of cubes within 3D representations, before learning how to find the volume using the formula length x width x height. Tiger Class have been learning how to find the mean of a given set of numbers and have ended the week reading and interpreting pie charts.
