Maths

We have been learning about fractions. To begin the unit, we have used the terms **whole** and **part, equal** and **unequal**. We have also learnt to recognise $\frac{1}{2}$ of a shape. Have a go at splitting simple 2D shapes in $\frac{1}{2}$ but remember both sides have to be equal!

English

This week we have written our own non-chronological report about an animal of our choice (hot task). I am so impressed with how much the children have remembered about the features of this text (as we learnt about it before Easter!) They're all superstars!

Topic- Art

We are having an art focus for the first two weeks of term. We are focusing our learning on the artist Henri Rousseau, famous for his Tiger in a Tropical Storm painting. This week we have explored his art using viewfinders and copied images of leaves that are repeated in his work. We noticed that there's always an animal hidden in his jungle paintings so next we we'll explore how we can hide an animal in the jungle!
