Maths

This week we finished our statistics unit, where the children have been reading and interpreting tables, including two-way tables, and reading timetables. We have also started learning about angles, focusing on understanding and using degrees.

English

In English, we started a new unit based on a *meeting/finding tale*. The children began with a cold task, writing their own story where a character meets a strange object or person. We then introduced our new model text, *Alien Landing*, and have started learning it through actions. The children have also been exploring key vocabulary, including definitions, synonyms and antonyms, and writing sentences to describe pictures using ambitious language.

Science

In science, we started a new unit on Living Things and Their Habitats. The children looked at plants and dissected a plant to learn about the different parts.

Topic

In topic, we started a new unit on the Anglo-Saxons. The children have been learning about where they came from and where they settled in Britain.

Reading

In reading, we began a new class book, *Alex Rider*. The children made predictions based on the front cover and blurb and have started reading the first chapter.

Our PE days are **Tuesday and Friday**. On Tuesdays, we are doing gymnastics, and on Fridays, we are playing cricket.
