



TIGER CLASS



In English, Tiger Class have been editing and improving their mystery/crime stories they wrote before the end of the spring term. The children have worked together and used editing stations such as: Punctuation Point, Spelling Square, Vocabulary Valley and Grammar Garden. As a class, we have also recapped on specific areas in writing such as 'show don't tell,' suspense and ensuring over-long sentences are more concise. Tigers are now in the process of writing a polished version of their stories.

In Maths, the children have been learning about angles and how to measure them using a protractor. Tigers have learnt that the angles inside a triangle add up to 180 degrees and have used this fact to calculate missing angles. The children have also been learning about special triangles for example, isosceles and how this knowledge can help them to calculate the missing angle.

This week, in the afternoons, we have started our new topic on 'The Ancient Greeks'

In PE we have started skills for Rounders, in computing we are learning about 'Powerpoint' and in Science we have started learning about 'Animal Classifications'.
