### **Maths**

This week we have continued our learning on fractions. We have learnt that the number on the bottom is the denominator and the number on top is the numerator. When the numerator is 1, it is a unit fraction ( $\frac{1}{4}$ ) and if it's more than 1, it's a non-unit fraction ( $\frac{3}{4}$ ). We have also learnt that  $\frac{1}{2}$  is equivalent to  $\frac{2}{4}$ . That's a lot to remember!

### **English**

We've had a super week with our Tear Thief story. We are experts at telling the story and have begun to think about changing descriptions to our preference. We had fun describing the different tears that different people could have, eg, a builder's dusty tears, a gymnast's long and bendy tears, and wrote this into poem using an apostrophe for possession. Very clever!

We have finished our artwork inspired by Henri Rousseau. I'm really impressed with how they created a busy jungle with hidden animals. We will start our new topic next week so keep your eyes peeled for the new POWER project.
