In our English lessons this week, we have finished writing our innovated versions of 'The Tiger Who Came to Tea'. We are so impressed with the children's work and how they have used adjectives, a variety of sentence starters and full stops, questions marks and exclamation marks! Well done, Leopards!

In maths we have started a new unit of work, looking at the place value of numbers up to 50. We have been counting forwards and backwards and understanding how many ones we need to make 10, 20, 30 40 and 50. We have also started to investigate how many tens and ones are needed to represent different numbers.

In our 'Save our Seas' topic, we linked our learning to Design and Technology. We investigated how wheel mechanisms work and explored the best way to attach a wheel mechanism to a poster. Over the next few weeks, we are going to design and make a poster with a wheel mechanism to encourage people to look after our seas.

During Science this week, we learnt about the difference between garden and wild plants. We had a go at drawing some of the plants and thinking about where we would find them when in a garden or in the wild.

In RE this week, we continued our learning about Sukkot. The children finished decorating a sukkah and loved walking around the classroom to look at each other's work.
