English

In English, we have been learning about folktales. We listened to a range of folktales from different cultures, such as The Empty Pot and Baba Yaga and have been making story maps of our class folktale, 'Lebo the Greedy Crocodile'. Whilst doing so, we have been learning new vocabulary and looking at the deeper meaning of the text.

Maths

In maths, we've been learning about angles. We went on a right-angle hunt outside to see where we could see right angles around the school. We have learnt that an acute angle is smaller than a right angle, whilst an obtuse angle is greater than a right angle.

This term we are continuing to focus on learning our 3s, 4s and 8 times tables.

Science

In science, we have been learning about the parts of a flower. In groups, we dissected lilies and identified the petals, sepal, stamen and carpel. We also sorted the parts into male and female and learnt about each function and how they work together to help reproduce more seeds.

Topic

This week, we have started a new topic on the Shang Dynasty! We placed it onto a timeline of all the historical events that we have learnt about so far.
