English

In English, we have been focusing on writing interesting openings and endings. We have practiced lots of skills, such as writing dialogue and using fronted adverbials that we can use in our folktales.

We did a shared version as a class, then wrote our own independently.

Maths

In maths, we've been learning about parallel and perpendicular lines. We learnt that parallel lines never meet, whereas perpendicular lines meet at a right angle. We have also been recapping 2D and 3D shapes, and identifying faces, edges and vertices.

This term we are continuing to focus on learning our 3s, 4s and 8 times tables.

Science

In science, we have been learning about pollination. Firstly, we looked at insect pollination and how insects take pollen to other plants to help them produce seeds. Then, we looked at wind pollination and how the wind blows the pollen onto the plant and compared both methods of pollination and looked at why the plants looked so different.

Topic

This week, we have been doing Geography and have been locating China in the atlases. We have also been looking at the human and physical features found in China, such as the Yellow River and the Great Wall of China.
