In English this week we have been working hard to finish our recounts of our trip To Little Owl Farm Park. The children have really enjoyed writing about their day, and we are super impressed with the amazing sentences that they have written!

In maths we have started a new unit of work on Fractions. We have been learning how to recognise a half of objects and shapes as well as finding a half of different amounts, We have also been looking at position and direction. The children practised using the language of left and right and learned to describe and make whole, three quarter, half and quarter turns. We also enjoyed giving and following simple directions to help develop our understanding of movement and position.

This week in Science, we've been learning about the different parts of a plant and what each part does. The children then used what they have learnt to design and label their own imaginary plant, thinking carefully about its roots, stem, leaves and flowers.

In our topic lessons we have been thinking about the difference between human and physical features in our school grounds, and the different types of houses and buildings that you might find in Tenbury

In RE, we explored some of Jesus' parables, including The Good Samaritan, The Lost Sheep and The Lost Son. We discussed how these stories teach Christians about showing love, kindness, forgiveness and caring for others. The children shared which story they liked best and thought carefully about questions such as, Does helping someone show love? and Do we have to forgive someone to show love?
