Maths

This week we finished our unit on volume, where the children estimated and compared the volume and capacity of different shapes and containers. Towards the end of the week, we began revising the key maths topics we have covered throughout the year and completed some practice test papers in preparation for our end-of-year assessments next week. The children have worked incredibly hard and should feel proud of the progress they have made.

English
