Dear Parents and Carers

Welcome to Nursery! All the children have settled really well into nursery and are beginning to follow the nursery routine. The staff in nursery, in addition to myself, are Mrs Perkins, Mrs Davies and Mrs Hatcher. If you have any questions or concerns at any point, please just ask. It would be really helpful if all your child's belongings are labelled, including drinks, jumpers and coats!

Key Person

While I oversee the learning and development of all the children in nursery, each child has a named key person. The role of the key person in nursery is to ensure that every child's care and learning is tailored to meet their needs. Over the coming days we will be letting you know who your child's key person is.

Google Classroom

We use Google Classroom to keep you informed of what your child is doing during the week. We also use it to share letters, advice and information. You will also be able to upload posts and pictures. Unfortunately, following a computer upgrade we are currently unable to access Google Classroom. When issues have been resolved, you will receive details of how to log on. Likewise, School Money is unavailable. The School Office will be in touch when it is accessible to parents.

Snack Contribution

We ask for a voluntary contribution of 20p a session (up to £1 a week) towards the snack we provide and cooking activities. There is a pot for money with the signing in register. All contributions are gratefully received.

Lunchboxes

At lunchtime we encourage all children to eat their healthy foods first before any sweets or treats. All children have at least 30 minutes to eat their dinner, plus a little extra time to finish off if necessary. We leave all packaging / uneaten food in the lunch boxes so that you can see what has been eaten. If your child has a yoghurt, please provide a spoon. Please note that we are a nut free school. Please also cut grapes in half (lengthways) to minimise the risk of choking.

This week we have enjoyed the story Chocolate Mousse for Greedy Goose. We have also been singing a variety of rhymes including Old McDonald had a Farm, Head

Shoulders Knees and Toes and Wheels on the Bus. We have enjoyed all sorts of play, puzzles, sand, waterplay, messy play, painting, dancing, musical instruments, listening games and much much more. This half term our Topic is All About Me. We will be thinking about ourselves, our bodies, our homes and our families. Our value of the half term is generosity.

Next week our story of the week is The Scarecrow and our rhyme of the week is Ten in the Bed. Each week we have a special "word of the week" which we focus on, including learning the sign language and a symbol for. This week the word is in. In maths we are focusing on counting and number.
