Dear Parents and Carers

This week we have shared the story The Scarecrow and we have talked about where you might see a Scarecrow. We have sung the rhymes Dingle Dangle Scarecrow and also 10 in a Bed. Our word this week was the word "in" and we have done lots of playing to support this, putting objects in bottles, dishes and boxes.



Additionally, we have started learning our Talk 4 Writing Story, Mr Wiggle and Mr Waggle. Talk 4 Writing is a structured approach that helps learners internalize language and develop independent writing skills through imitation, innovation, and invention. In nursery we learn to recite the story following a story map that we have produced. We can then start to innovate the story, changing parts of it to make it our own. Throughout the process we look at the language used, helping the children to develop a wider range of vocabulary.

Throughout the week we have enjoyed a range of activities inside and out, including exploring the school field, worship time, playing on the activity blocks, circle time, painting outside, messy play and musical instruments.

Next week our story of the week is Rosie's Walk and we will be learning a range of finger play rhymes such as 2 Little Dickie Birds and Tommy Thumb. The word of the week is **through**. In maths we will be focusing on directional language.
