Dear Parents and Carers

Welcome to the Autumn term to both our existing families and our new ones. The children have settled in well this week to the nursery routine. This week we have enjoyed a range of stories such as The Hungry Caterpillar, Maisy's Dream, Peppa's First Pet and Duck's Truck. We have also been exploring which nursery rhymes the children already know. Old McDonald and Wheels on the Bus are popular!

This half term our Topic is All About Me. We will be thinking about ourselves, our bodies, our homes and our families. Next week our story of the week is Where's Spot? and we are learning a range of fingerplays, including: Tommy Thumb, Once I caught a fish. Incy wincy, This little piggy and 2 Little Dickie Birds. In our maths we are practising counting and number. Each week we have a special "word of the week" which we focus on, including learning the sign language. This week the word is "Where". A version of the story and some rhymes are on Google Classroom.

Key Person

While I oversee the learning and development of all the children in nursery, each child has a named key person. The role of the key person in nursery is to ensure that every child's care and learning is tailored to meet their needs. Over the coming days we will be letting you know who your child's key person is.
