Dear Parents and Carers

This week we have been talking about our feelings and emotions. We have been sharing the story *The Colour Monster* and talking about what makes us happy, sad and scared. We have also enjoyed sharing the autumn bags at circle time - talking about the objects inside and using them as a focus for our maths. We have counted feathers, compared lengths of sticks and made patterns from the objects.



We have also been learning the rhyme, *Bumping Up and Down on a Big Red Tractor*. We have been looking at different fruit and vegetables and starting to think about Harvest time.



Next week our story of the week is *Come On Daisy* by Jane Simmons. It is a lovely little story about a duckling who doesn't do good listening and gets lost. Luckily, her mummy finds her and from then on, Daisy always does good listening. It's a wonderful opportunity to discuss why we need to do 'good listening' and what the consequences can be when we don't. Our Rhyme next week is *Dingle Dangle*
