

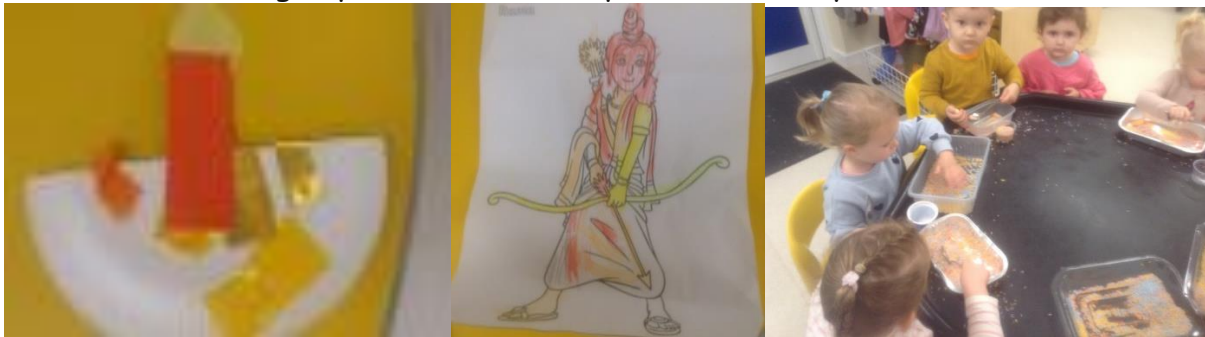
Friday 24th October 2025
