Dear Parents and Carers

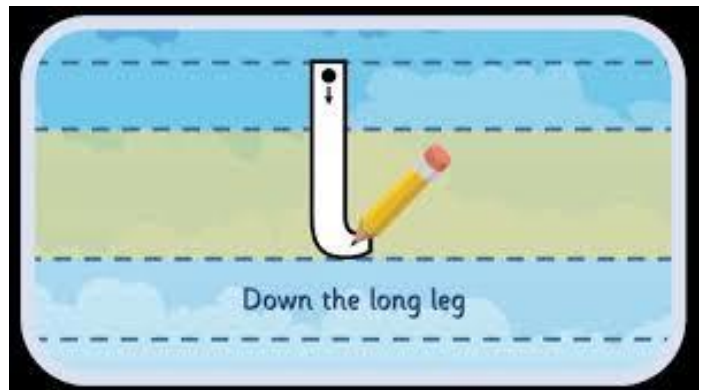
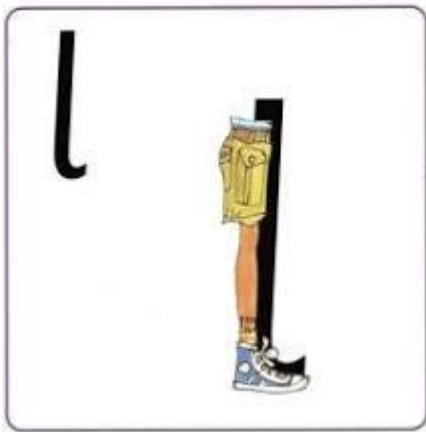
