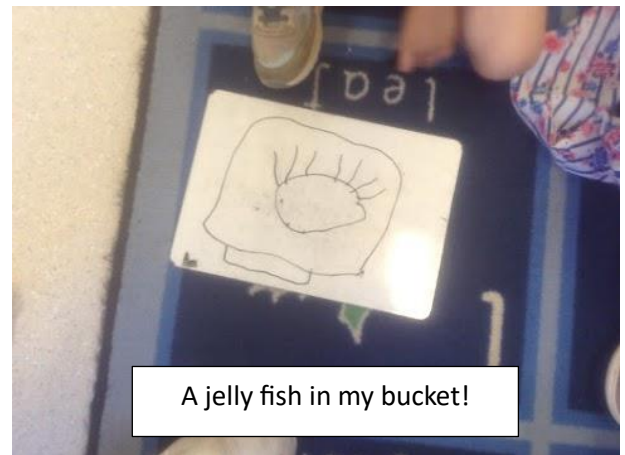

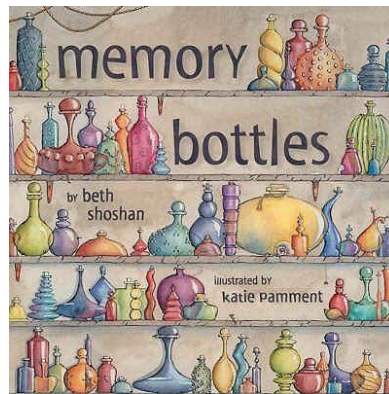
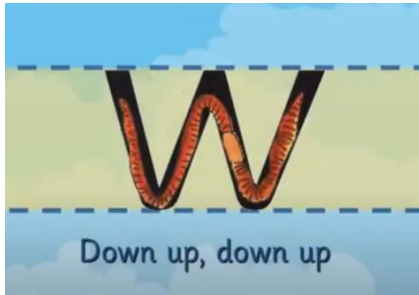
Dear Parents and Carers

Key Dates

Taster Day in School 2) Monday 14th July 2025 - 1.30-3pm

All Reception intake children are to come to Nursery on Monday 14th July for 1.15pm to be registered. This is regardless of whether they attend on a Monday afternoon or not. (If they are normally in nursery on a Monday lunch time they are to attend as per usual times.)

Nursery staff will toilet the children ready for the start of their session in Reception. They will be collected from Nursery by Mrs Baker. The children will be returned to Nursery at 3pm. They will be dismissed from nursery.

If your child does not attend nursery normally on a Monday afternoon, you will need to collect them from Nursery at 3pm.

Children that normally attend on a Monday afternoon can stay until 3.20pm, when they should be collected as normal from Nursery.
