Dear Parents and Carers

This was the last week before half term and all our children are in need of a good rest. This week we have shared the story Whatever Next and thought about different types of air travel and space. This is a big topic area and we will be revisiting this later in the year.

This week was also Internet Safety Week. We have talked about how we use tablets and phones at home - for example to watch cartoons or play games. We talked about what to do if an advert or "pop up" box occurs and the importance of getting help from an adult and not just clicking on unknown links. We then drew pictures of our favourite game or program.



After half term our theme is People Who Help Us and we will be learning about people who help keep us safe and healthy or help us in the Community. We will learn about the Police, Firefighters, doctors, nurses, dentists, farmers and vets. We are hoping to have visits from the local library, firefighters, Police Officers

and a Nurse. We will start by thinking about people who help in and around school including Mr Robson (school caretaker), Mrs Newall (school office), the local postal worker and Vicar.

Our story of the week is Mr Busy's Post (A Mr Men Book) - Mr Busy has to deliver the post to his friends and we find out what is in the parcels, letters and cards. We will look at the address for where we live and write our own letters and cards to post home. Our phoneme of the week is i for insect. We will be recapping the phonemes we have covered so far (m,a,s,d,n,t). Our rhyme of the week is The Postman.

### The Postman

Lots of letters in the postman's sack  
He knocks on the door with a rat a tat tat

The letter falls down on the floor.  
(repeat with different names)
