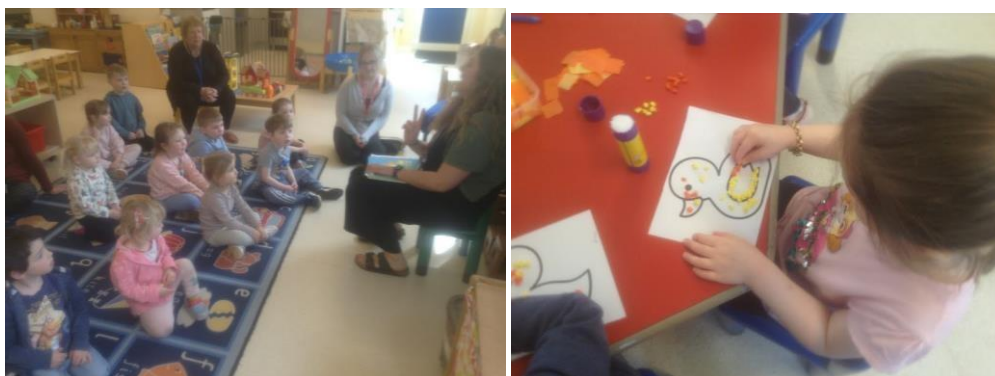


Friday 11<sup>th</sup> April 2025

### **Sunny Weather**

*"Parents will be encouraged to use 'all day' sunscreen lotions for their children (minimum SPF 30, 4 star UVA) which they could apply before their child attends school each morning."*

In individual cases where there are specific medical needs, parents must supply a letter to school giving permission to staff to apply sunscreen. Sun screen must be supplied in a named bottle and will only be applied to a child's face, neck and arms. Please ensure that your child is wearing a t shirt with sleeves to avoid burning their neck and shoulders.

### **Gate Security**

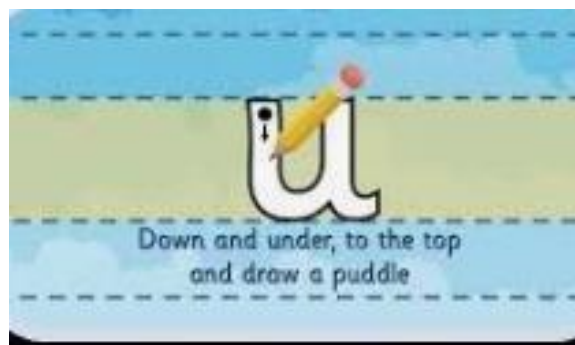
