Dear Parents and Carers

Welcome to our new nursery! The children have settled in well this week to both the new nursery building and the nursery routine. We are still fine tuning the layout inside to provide the children with the best learning opportunities possible. Over the coming weeks we will be focusing on the outdoor area. We are still awaiting the arrival of our new cloakroom trolley and this is making logistics at the start and end of the day more difficult. Please ensure that all your child's belongings are labelled.

Thank you also for your patience regarding the use of gate on the footpath. We are awaiting the installation of a push release button on the inside of the gate so that parents can let themselves out after dropping off or collecting their child. Please ensure that you do not hold the gate open for anyone entering the site that you don't know. Please ensure that the gate has closed behind you.

Key Person

While I oversee the learning and development of all the children in nursery, each child has a named key person. The role of the key person in nursery is to ensure that every child's care and learning is tailored to meet their needs. Over the coming days we will be letting you know who your child's key person is.

Lunchboxes

Please also cut grapes in half (lengthways) to minimise the risk of choking.

This week we have enjoyed the story The Three Little Pigs. We have also been singing a variety of rhymes including Old McDonald had a Farm, Head Shoulders

Knees and Toes and 5 Little Firemen. This half term our Topic is All About Me. We will be thinking about ourselves, our bodies, our homes and our families.

Next week our story of the week is Little Red Riding Hood and our rhyme of the week is Tommy Thumb. We will be thinking about who is in our family. Each week we have a special "word of the week" which we focus on, including learning the sign language and a symbol for. This week the word is big. In maths we are focusing on counting and number.

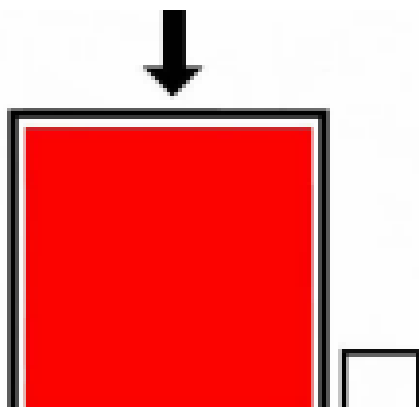
