Dear Parents and Carers

On Thursday, when we went for our nature walk, we were very fortunate to see a Tawny Owl sitting in a tree at the far end of the school field! It was amazing to see an owl so close up and a great opportunity to find out more about owls. We shared the story Owl Babies.



This week we have been reading the story Dear Santa and have written our own letter to Father Christmas. We have posted the letter and are awaiting to hear back from him! We have also read the Nativity Story in preparation for the Christmas Nativity Play. Finally, we celebrated World Nursery Rhyme Week - enjoying a different rhyme each day.

Next week our story is Rainbow Fish, which is the story of a very beautiful fish with sparkly scales who is too proud to play with the other fish in the ocean. However, over time he comes to realise that friendship is more important than being beautiful and he learns to share his sparkly scales.

Our word of the week is share. Our rhyme of the week is 1,2,3,4,5 Once I caught a Fish Alive. In maths we are focusing on subitising - the rapid recognition of a number of objects without counting them.

One, Two, Three, Four, Five!

One, two, three, four, five,
Once I caught a fish alive.
Six, seven, eight, nine, ten,
Then I let it go again.
Why did you let it go?
Because it bit my finger so
Which finger did it bite?
This little finger on my right.
