In English this week we have been learning the story of 'The Gingerbread Man'. We have been using story maps to help us re-tell the story and actions and drama to help us understanding new words such as 'peckish'.

In Maths, we have been practising our counting skills and learning how to recognise numbers when they are written as words.

We have also continued learning about 3D and 2D shapes. We confidently sorted 3D shapes thinking carefully about their properties to help us and towards the end of the week, we started looking at 2D shapes. We will continue our work on 2D and 3D shapes next week.

In our topic lessons we have been looking at how a hot air balloon works and we have used the art technique of pointillism to design our own hot air balloon.
