In English we have continued to use story maps to retell the story of the Gingerbread Man. We have also used characters from the story to write simple sentences which have included adjectives and verbs.

In Maths, we have been learning about '1 more'. We have used cubes, tens frames and number lines to help us to understand this tricky concept. We have also continued learning about 2D shapes. The children enjoyed drawing around 2D shapes to create pictures and playing 'Guess my 2D shape'. We sorted 2D shapes and also started looking at shape patterns.

In our topic lessons we have been finding out about the Wright brothers, who were the inventors of the first airplane.

Homework

To support our Topic learning, children also choose POWER projects to complete at home during the half term. The aim is to collect 5 points! There's lots of tasks and activities that they can choose from, and we love sharing their work with the rest of the class.
