Maths

In maths this week, we finished our unit on addition and subtraction and have started a new unit on multiplication and division. This week, we have been focusing on sharing numbers into equal groups (e.g. 20 can be shared into 5 equal groups of 4, or 4 equal groups of 5).

This term, we are focusing on practicing our 2s, 5s and 10s times tables. We have been playing fun multiplayer games, such as tug of war and tables tennis (see links below) to help strengthen our times table knowledge.

English

In English this week, we have been learning all the features that we will need to write our own stories about the Stone Trolls next week and have built a characterisation toolkit to help us to create characters that will be easy for the reader to imagine.

Topic

This week, we have been learning about how the Stone Age was split into three periods: The Palaeolithic Period (Old Stone Age), Mesolithic Period (Middle Stone Age) and Neolithic Period (New Stone Age) and have been making timelines to show this.

Science

In Science this week, we have been investigating the physical properties of different types of rocks. We investigated which rocks were the most waterproof and durable and used our findings to identify which rocks would be best suited for various purposes.
