Maths

This week in maths, we have been developing our place value skills further. The children have been partitioning numbers, working with number lines up to 1,000,000, and learning how to compare and order large numbers. Towards the end of the week, we also began looking at rounding numbers to the nearest 10, 100, and 1,000.

English

In English, we have been building our warning tales writing skills. The children created a setting toolkit before boxing up and planning their own stories. They have made a fantastic start to their writing, completing the first and second paragraphs of their own warning tales with great imagination and detail.

Science

In science, we continued our topic on Earth and Space by looking at the orbits of different planets. To help understand this, we went outside and acted out the orbits of the planets, exploring which are closest to the sun, which are furthest away, and how many years each planet takes to orbit. The children really enjoyed this practical activity and showed excellent understanding.

Today we have completed our spelling and times table tests. I have also been checking reading records. All these things happen weekly, so, as mentioned previously, please try and make sure the children are completing these activities at home.
