### **Maths**

This week, we completed our place value unit, and the children worked hard on their end-of-unit assessment, showing great progress and understanding. We have now started our addition and subtraction unit, beginning with mental strategies and adding whole numbers with more than four digits.

### **English**

In English, we have finished innovating on our model text *The Canal*, adapting it to make our own warning tales and improving them. Next week, the children will complete their independent 'hot task', where they will write their own warning tale from start to finish.

### **Science**

In science, we investigated how the Earth's movement makes it appear as though the sun is moving, and how this causes shadows to change throughout the day. The children enjoyed making observations and discussing their findings.
