Maths

This week in maths, we have been focusing on addition and subtraction. The children have been subtracting numbers with more than four digits, using rounding to check their answers, applying inverse operations for addition and subtraction, and tackling a range of multi-step problems.

English

In English, the children completed their hot task by writing their own warning tales, drawing on everything they have learned over the past few weeks. We also introduced our next unit with a cold task, where the children wrote a discussion text on the question: "Is homework necessary?"

Science

In science, we explored the rotation of the Earth on its axis, modelling and demonstrating how this creates day and night, as well as influencing the seasons. The children showed excellent curiosity and asked thoughtful questions about how our planet works.

PE

The children have also been thoroughly enjoying their PE lessons this week, showing great enthusiasm in both tag rugby and gymnastics. It has been fantastic to see their teamwork and energy in action.
