Maths

This week, we finished our addition and subtraction unit and completed the end-of-unit assessment, with the children showing excellent progress and understanding. We have now started our multiplication and division unit, focusing on identifying multiples and common multiples.

English

In English, we have been exploring discussion texts through the question “Should Mrs Mac let the boys out?” The children have been examining key vocabulary, learning how to structure counterarguments, and providing clear points with supporting evidence. We also focused on using colons accurately and created a discussion writing toolkit to support future work.

Science

In science, we looked at how the Moon orbits the Earth and modelled this movement to help understand the lunar cycle. The children enjoyed taking part and demonstrating their understanding of how the Moon’s position changes in relation to Earth and the Sun.

Trip

Today, we went on an exciting trip to the Discovery Centre, where the children investigated the features of a river - linking perfectly with our geography topic. They measured the current at different parts of the river and observed which sections were the fastest. Everyone had a fantastic day and represented the school brilliantly!
