### **Maths**

This week, we finished our multiplication and division unit. The children have been multiplying and dividing by 10, 100 and 1000. They also completed their end-of-unit assessment and showed great effort and understanding.

### **English**

In English, we completed our discussion text unit. After finishing “Is homework necessary?”, the children planned and wrote their own discussion texts on topics of their choice, such as “Should school uniforms be compulsory?” and “Should you get a day off on your birthday?” They worked hard to include key features such as balanced arguments, evidence, conjunctions and colons.
