Maths

In maths this week, we have been learning how to order and compare fractions by finding common denominators and understanding their values. We have also started adding and subtracting fractions with the same denominators.

English

In English, we started the week by writing suspense poems, using a range of poetic devices such as similes, metaphors, and personification to create atmosphere and tension. We then created a suspense writing toolkit to identify key techniques, before planning our own suspense stories. The children have shown fantastic creativity and are building strong descriptive skills.

Topic

In topic, we have been exploring why people choose to settle near rivers, discussing both the positive and negative impacts of living close to water. The children considered how rivers provide resources such as water, transport, and fertile land, as well as the potential risks like flooding and pollution.

Computing

In computing this week, we have been learning about vector drawings - exploring what they are and how they are created using shapes and layers. The children then had a go at producing their own vector drawings of a house, showing great creativity and precision.
