Maths

In maths this week, we finished our fractions unit. The children have been subtracting fractions, subtracting from mixed numbers, and subtracting two mixed numbers. They also completed their end-of-unit assessment and showed great progress and determination.

English

In English, we have started a new non-fiction unit on non-chronological reports. The children began with a cold task, writing a fact file about a famous river. Later in the week, we explored the key features of a non-chronological report, highlighting examples in model texts. We have also learned how to use parentheses effectively to add extra information to our writing.

Science

In science, we investigated water resistance. The children tested different shapes in a beaker of water to see which shape experienced the most water resistance and which sank to the bottom the fastest. They loved predicting, testing and comparing their results.

In art, we painted our clay lily pads. The children really enjoyed adding colour and bringing their clay creations to life!
