



# TIGER CLASS



In English, Tigers have been learning the story 'Kidnapped.' As a whole class, we have created a story map to help us with retelling it. Besides learning this, the children have been developing their knowledge of different word classes and writing short sentences to create tension and suspense. They also completed a role on the wall for Cindy Breakwell, the ambassador's daughter, inferring how she would have felt during different parts of the story.

In Maths, Tiger Class have been reading and writing numbers to 10,000,000 in numerals and words. They have consolidated and extended their knowledge of powers of ten and the effect this has on the place value of digits within numbers. The children have ended the week locating numbers on number lines by calculating intervals.

During the afternoons, Tiger class have begun reading their class guided reading text 'Clockwork' by Philip Pullman. They have begun their topic on Earthquakes and Volcanoes and this week learnt about Plate Tectonics. In Science, Tigers are learning about the Circulatory System and this week they learnt about the contents of blood.

In PE, the children began to develop their basketball skills and in Art they learnt how to mix different shades of blue and green.
