



TIGER CLASS



In English, Tiger Class have been identifying the underlying pattern of *Kidnapped*. The children have also completed a range of short burst activities linked to sentence structure and punctuation. Following the theme of *Kidnapped*, we have share-written our own 'box it up' plan and are now beginning to share-write each paragraph.

In Maths, Tiger Class have been continuing to work on place value. The children have been comparing and ordering integers and rounding them to the nearest 10, 100, 1,000 etc. The children have been developing their knowledge of negative numbers and answering questions about these in context. The children have ended the week completing a short assessment on their learning so far,

During the afternoons, Tiger class have continued reading *'Clockwork'* by Philip Pullman. This week they wrote their own versions of Fritz's story. In geography the children drew and labelled a cross section diagram of a volcano and in Science they learnt about the parts of the heart.

In PE, Tigers continued to practice basketball skills and in Art they practiced drawing Japanese blossom trees.
