



TIGER CLASS



In English, Tiger class have continued to write their last few paragraphs of their story based on 'Kidnapped.' As part of this week's work, the children have also been editing and improving their work. Tigers have also planned a new version of the story which they will write independently to show what they have learnt.

In Maths, Tigers have been developing their knowledge of prime, square and cube numbers. The children have also been revising the written method for multiplication of a three-digit number by a two-digit number before extending their learning to four-digit numbers. Tigers ended the week by applying skills learnt to problem solving.

During the afternoons, Tiger class have enjoyed reading more of their class text Clockwork. This week they made predictions about what a character called 'Sir Ironsoul' might get up to in the story.

In Art, the children evaluated their Mount Fuji paintings and in Science they learnt about different blood vessels including Arteries, Veins and Capillaries. In Geography, Tigers learnt about the advantages and disadvantages of living near a Volcano and in RE they learnt about the cycle of Samsara as part of their work on Hinduism.
