



TIGER CLASS



In English, Tiger Class have been busy writing a new version of 'Kidnapped,' independently. The children have evaluated their writing and identified improvements they have made within it. Tigers have completed a 'Cold Task' in which they had to write a newspaper report about the floods in Tenbury Wells. The children have been introduced to our whole class text, 'Blizzard Causes Chaos!' Tiger Class have identified how the report is organised and have found out the meanings of unfamiliar words.

In Maths, Tiger Class have been developing their knowledge of division. The children have been dividing up to four-digit numbers by a single digit number before moving on to dividing by a two-digit number. Tigers have ended the week, solving problems related to division.

During the afternoons, Tiger class have continued to read Clockwork. They have enjoyed making predictions about what will happen next in the story and have really enjoyed all the twists and turns. In Art, the children wrote a fact file about the artist Hokusai and in RE they continued to learn about the idea of Karma, in Hinduism. For their work in Geography, Tiger class found out about why Earthquakes occur and what can be done to help if an Earthquake occurs.
