



# TIGER CLASS



In English, we have been busy share writing the build-up of our warning stories. The children have then used the model to support them with writing their own. Tiger Class have also evaluated a paragraph for the problem within the story. The children then continued with their own ensuring that they had included short, sharp sentences for the danger.

In Maths, the children have been continuing to learn about fractions. This week, Tiger Class have been: multiplying fractions by an integer, multiplying a fraction by a fraction, dividing a fraction by an integer and finding fractions of amounts. The children decided that once they knew the rules, the calculations were not too tricky. It would be great though, if you could check that they have remembered them as there have been several of them this week.

To multiply a fraction by an integer - multiply the numerator (only) by the whole number.

To multiply a fraction by a fraction - multiply the numerators and then multiply the denominators.

To divide a fraction by an integer - multiply the denominator by the whole number (do not change the numerator)

To find the fraction of an amount - divide the amount by the denominator and multiply the answer by the numerator.

During the afternoons, Tiger class have researched Viking longboats and then drew them using sketching pencils. In Science, they learnt about renewable and non-renewable energy sources and in guided reading they continued to discuss the book 'The Arrival' by Shaun Tan.
