English

In English this week, we have been writing our hot tasks for our dialogue unit and have started our cold tasks for our new unit next week on biographies.

Maths

In maths this week, we have started a new unit on length and perimeter. We have been looking at measuring in m, cm and mm, and have started looking at converting measurements e.g. 10mm = 1cm.

Science

This week, we have been exploring how shadows are made. We conducted a fair test and tested which objects made a shadow and which did not and had a go at making shadow animals with our hands. We found that opaque objects, such as the wooden block, made a shadow, whereas transparent objects, such as a glass, did not.

Topic

This week, we have been learning about what a pharaoh was and some of the jobs that they were responsible for.

We learnt more about the five pillars of Islam whilst we were there and got to look at the different areas within the Mosque.
