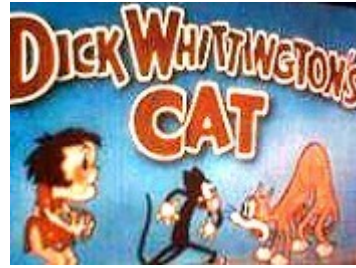

CUT YOUR CARBON



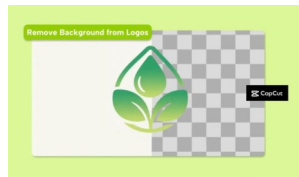
