FREE SCHOOL MEALS

There is a strong possibility that many of our families may be entitled to Free School Meals but are not claiming them. Even if your child already has a free meal (because all children do in Reception, Y1 and Y2) if you make a successful claim you will receive weekly vouchers on your phone of £10 per child during the school holidays, which can be used in all major supermarkets. It also means that school receive extra funding which can either be used for your child personally, or to support all children in the school through resources or staffing. If you think you may be eligible simply click the link below and complete the (very short!) form.

BENEFIT RELATED CRITERIA

- Universal Credit, and your annual household income is £7,400 per annum (£616 per month) or less after tax, and not including any benefits
- Income Support
- Income-based Jobseekers Allowance
- Support under part 6 of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999
- Child Tax Credit, provided you are not also entitled to Working Tax Credit and your annual income is less than £16,190, as assessed by HMRC
- Guaranteed Pension Credit
- Income-based Employment and Support Allowance
- Working Tax Credit run-on
