IMPORTANT INFORMATION FOR PARENTS/CARERS

Please see in Google Classroom and the School Website important information on giving your consent/decline the flu immunisation for pupils in Reception-Y6.

This message is from the NHS:

It is really important that all parents complete the E-Consent form. Even if the parents decline the vaccine, we still need the consent form completed. This will ensure that the child does NOT get vaccinated, and we do not have to continuously chase for consent forms. We would appreciate any support with chasing outstanding consent forms — you can track these on the School Portal. If you need access, contact Vaccination UK.

ATTENDANCE

Good attendance (96% and above) is crucial to ensure that children have the best possible opportunities to flourish in their education. Even a 1% rise or fall in attendance can make a difference to attainment. Studies have shown that students with attendance over 95% are twice as likely to achieve Grade 5 in English and Maths than students attending 90% of the time.

Good attendance habits start in Primary School, which will then help you when your child moves on to their secondary education.

Our academy trust, the DHMAT, have issued a new Attendance Policy, to be followed by all of their schools. This is also reflecting changes by the Department of Education, with a tightening up of fines for unauthorised absences.
