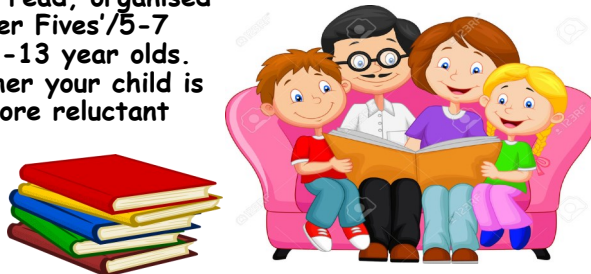
## NATIONAL STORYTELLING WEEK
