Week 1 - Welcome to The Year of Reading

This year, our school proudly celebrates 2026 - The Year of Reading.

Reading is at the heart of learning. It builds vocabulary, imagination, confidence and understanding, and supports children across every subject area.

At home: Create a calm daily reading routine, even if it's just 10 minutes.

Recommended read: *The Very Hungry Caterpillar* by Eric Carle — a delightful beginning to reading for all ages.



Week 2 - Why Reading Matters



Reading strengthens memory, focus and thinking skills. Children who read regularly develop stronger comprehension and communication skills over time.

At home: Talk about what was read and ask questions to develop understanding.

Recommended read: *Where the Wild Things Are* — a classic adventure that sparks imagination.

It is based on designs created by the children last term. Children from each class have worked together with Rachel to create a large piece of mosaic art work which looks amazing. We now need to find the best place to display it! Well done to Henry in Y3 for creating the winning design - he was presented with his certificate and prize this week!

Thank you to Becky and Alice as well for installing the new planters around school. Excess water from drainpipes will now drain into the planters rather than onto the tarmac, reducing the amount of surface water on parts of the school site. This is one of the strategies, together with the hedge that has been planted along the railings and the two green roof shelters, to help absorb more surface water.

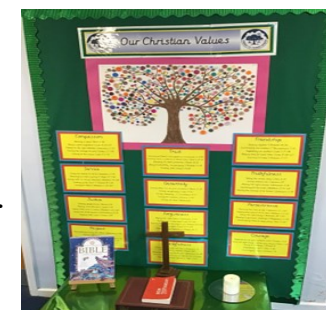
